



Consideration of Life Membership

A nomination should be made in writing to the Committee providing the rationale to support the nomination. Nominations can be made at any time, but ideally they should be made no later than the end of November of each year so that there is time for the Committee to undertake its consideration in advance of the AGM, and for club members to be notified of the recommendation as part of the AGM agenda. The nomination should provide sufficient detail for the committee (who may not know the nominee personally) to make a decision.

- Ideally the person being nominated should be a financial member of the club, and should have been so for at least 5 years.
- The efforts of the individual being nominated need to be above and beyond the usual “call of duty” in terms of effort or over an extended period of time - being a committee member or an office holder of the club and doing the job expected is not automatically criteria for nomination.
- Length of service, especially as an office holder of the club, may be considered. Undertaking a service to the club for a long period of time (minimum 5 years if this is the primary consideration).
- Positive consideration should be given to individuals who have gone to extraordinary lengths to organise and promote activities or membership of the club in their region.
